## **Operation Somebody Cares Suggested Offering for Shipping Costs to Locations Inside the USA**

There is no minimum quantity for an order. The suggested offering of three cents per tract includes shipping to an address in the USA.

If you want us to ship to a street address in the USA, most of the time we ship with the United Parcel Service. If you want us to ship to a PO Box in the USA, we will ship using the United States Postal Service. If it is to a location outside the USA, we use the US Postal Service.

If you want to order more than 10,000 tracts to a location in the USA, we can save money by shipping using Yellow Freight. Please contact us so we can check exact shipping costs. [www.myyellow.com](http://www.myyellow.com)

## **Operation Somebody Cares Suggested Offering for Shipping Costs to Locations Outside the USA**

The US Postal Service has a Priority Mail Flat-Rate Envelope with a four pound limit. We can fit around 112 tracts. It costs \$9.95 to send tracts or gospels to Canada or Mexico. It costs \$11.95 to send the tracts or gospels to every other country in the world besides Canada and Mexico.

The US Postal Service has a Priority Mail Flat-Rate Box with a 20 pound limit. We can fit around 600 tracts in this box. It costs \$23.95 to send the tracts and gospels to Canada or Mexico. It costs \$38.95 to send the 600 tracts and gospels to every other country in the world besides Canada and Mexico.

The US Postal Service has a Large Priority Mail Flat-Rate Box with a 20 pound limit. We can fit around 800 tracts in this box. It costs \$29.95 to send the tracts and gospels to Canada or Mexico. It costs \$49.95 to send the tracts and gospels to every other country in the world besides Canada and Mexico.

## **Operation Somebody Cares Reduced Shipping Costs of Tracts and Gospels to the Philippines and to US Military Addresses**

We have discounted rates to ship to a US military address.

There is a special rate to the Philippines. It is sent in something called a balikbayan box. It will cost around \$100 US dollars to ship to Manila door to door. The size of the box is 24 inches by 17 inches by 24 inches. We are able to send up to 11,000 tracts in this box. If we send the Gospel of John or Romans instead of tracts, we will be able to send less quantity since they are larger. It takes between two to five months to get there. If you want to order more than 1,500 tracts for the Philippines, it is more economical to send them in a balikbayan box.
